What has the GBCC done for you?

- Pioneered the annual PumpkinFest, drawing an estimated 2,000 people to the region
- Introduced the Barryville Farmers' Market in 2006. Market runs every Saturday from June to October.
- Partnered with a local prison to grow seeds for entrepreneurs and local non-profit organization wishing to become vendors at the Barryville Farmers' Market.
- Launched the Annual GBCC Mid Winter Warm Up party and fundraiser.
- Created a one time event/fund raiser, "Barryville for Broadway". The GBCC imported the best of Broadway to raise funds for the GBCC and the UDPC's Fight The NYRI Powerline fund. The event, located at the NACL Theater in Highland Lake, sold out both performances!
- The annual Barryville Christmas Tree Lighting and bonfire, drawing a larger crowd of people each year.
- Provided extensive radio and print advertising on the Greater Barryville region.
- GBCC partnered with the Highland Renaissance Committee to establish and maintain the Barryville Information Station.
- Created the \$2,500 GBCC Civic Scholarship Program for a local high school student wishing to pursue higher education.
- Provided ongoing beautification of the Route 97 and the Delaware River scenic historic byway with planters, banners and seasonal flowers.
- Initiated and expanded the www.BarryvilleNY.com web site.
- Provided ribbon cutting ceremonies and press coverage.
- Established a Greater Barryville Chamber of Commerce phone number: 845-557-6500.
- Participated in local parades.
- Established the GBCC annual networking breakfast.

What has the GBCC done for you? *continued*

- Awarded a \$30,000 Sullivan Renaissance Category C grant for Main Street Beautification from the Gerry Foundation.
- Won the \$3,000 Sullivan Renaissance Historical Preservation Award for the Barryville Information Station.
- Secured a \$3,000 grant from the Economic Development Assistance Program (EDAP).
- Was awarded a \$4,000 grant from The Catskill Center for Conservation and Development for banners along Route 97.
- Created the first visioning symposium for the Barryville residents which took place over the course of three months with a professional facilitator and coordination with the Sullivan County Department of Planning and The Catskill Center. Follow-up visioning work with the Department of Planning, The Catskill Center and Highland Renaissance continues in 2006.
